This morning we are going to be thinking about some people who made **THE GREAT DISCOVERY**

I wonder have you ever discovered something? Maybe found something special in a cupboard, or perhaps discovered a great toy or game in a shop? It's really exciting isn't.

There have been some wonderful discoveries such as finding gold coins in the ground or maybe special jewellery. Some in the lab have discovered wonderful cures for terrible illnesses.

A friend of mine told be a little while ago that had a call from a woman, "who is this?" he said, and she replied: "I am you sister!" The had been separated when very little. What a surprise can you imagine it! Another birthday to celebrate.

Well Christmas is a time to celebrate the birth of someone very special coming into this world.

Special people, important people are born in smart hospitals or palaces surrounded by medical staff.

When this special baby was born it was in a stable, like a big garden shed, a place where all the animals are kept.

No-one new about it except the parents.
