




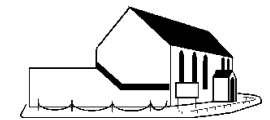

Christian - Expect Suffering!

"We need to remind ourselves that both faith in Christ and suffering for Christ are equally gifts of grace" **For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe in him, but also to suffer for him...** Phil 1:29
Affliction is the identification mark of God's people. It is simply what is characteristic of them, and Daniel's heading underscores that. He is saying that the future history of God's people will involve great suffering. It is simply 'par for the course'. But we are not told this to break us down but to brace us up, not to make us sombre but to make us prepared.
